1. About NatureFinance

NatureFinance is a Swiss-based, international not-for-profit organisation dedicated to aligning global finance with more equitable, nature positive outcomes. We work to make nature count in global finance and the global economy. NatureFinance is active in advancing the use of data to disclose and manage nature related risks, developing impactful and equitable nature markets, and advancing financial innovation in the areas of sovereign debt and nature positive investment. We develop tools to help financial actors better assess and align their investments with nature positive outcomes and push for stronger costs and consequences where finance is failing to address nature liabilities.

2. Nature Market Workstream

Nature markets are a sub-set of the economy where nature is specifically traded and valued. This includes large markets such as agricultural commodities and emerging markets that reflect the growing economic value of nature, such as nature-based solutions for carbon sequestration.

NatureFinance believes that if markets can be shaped to treat nature as a valuable and regenerative asset, they can play an important role in addressing nature loss, climate change, equality and food security issues. Our work on shaping nature markets aims to place nature and equity at the centre of how we build and run businesses, markets and economies.

We believe that achieving high-integrity, high-performing nature markets requires a radical level of transparency and accountability, accreditation for traders, ensuring affected voices are heardeand at the decision-making table, minimum price floors established, and nature's stewards are equitably benefiting, and international governance arrangements significantly upgraded.

NatureFinance is working with a wide range of partners to develop frameworks and recommendations for shaping high-performance and high-integrity markets—with a particular focus on biodiversity or "biocredits"--and interrogating the risks and opportunities that accompany market-led approaches to financing biodiversity.

3. Project Assistant Position overview

The Project Assistant will manage the successful delivery of a dynamic and multi-faceted portfolio of work. The initial priority will be to support the Biocredit workstream, working closely with the nature market team members who own the projects.

- Collating material and drafting internal/external-facing progress reports
- Researching and drafting written content for use in meetings and policy/stakeholder engagements (e.g. short technical notes, slide decks, policy briefing papers)
- Support in researching and drafting material for publication (reports, papers, op-eds, presentations, etc.) and organizing their copyediting, design, and publication via the comms team
- Preparing and presenting material in project and broader team meetings, e.g. project updates and proposals for additional phases of work, note-taking and project coordination Support.
- Undertaking research and analysis as required by the project managers
- Supporting on stakeholder management and communication.
- Supporting on events briefing and content preparations.
